XIII. SUSPENSION AND TERMINATION OF THE PLAN

Unless extended by order of the Supreme Court, this plan will expire on December 31, 2004. The plan may be suspended or terminated by the Supreme Court upon a determination by the Court that there is an inadequate number of qualified mediators available to meet the demand without undue delay in the disposition of cases, or for such other reason as the Court may deem appropriate.
