ORDER

By order of this Court, issued March 22, 2001, Rule 4.02 of the Uniform Rules of Circuit and County Court Practice was amended to require a deposit of One Thousand Dollars for cases in which a complaint is filed pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 11-27-81. Following public comment, the Court entered an order on April 12, 2001, suspending the effect of the amendment pending further study. After due consideration, the Court now finds that the March 22, 2001, amendment to Rule 4.02 should be repealed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the March 22, 2001, amendment to Rule 4.02, requiring a deposit of One Thousand Dollars for a complaint filed pursuant to Miss. Code Ann. § 11-27-81 is hereby repealed. Rule 4.02 shall read as follows:

Rule 4.02 COST DEPOSIT

1. A cost deposit shall be made with the clerk of the court at the time of the filing of the complaint in the amount of \$75.00.
