

WHAT IS MEC?

Beginning in 2005, the Mississippi Supreme Court began a measured and comprehensive move to evaluate, test, and implement electronic filing and case management in Mississippi courts. Since May 2008, the Madison County Chancery Clerk's office has been testing a version of the federal Case Management/Electronic Case Filing (CM/ECF) system, now referred to as the Mississippi Electronic Courts (MEC) system. The MEC system is a comprehensive, internet-based document filing and case management system that allows courts to maintain electronic case files and offer electronic filing. Courts can make all case information immediately available electronically through the Internet. The design of CM/ECF provides for low-cost user access to the system. Any modern PC with Internet access and Web browser software can access MEC.

MEC is currently in pilot testing in Madison County Chancery Court with plans to expand pilot testing Scott County and Warren County Chancery Courts as well as Madison County Circuit Court in the near future.
