Microsoft Internet Explorer

- Internet Explorer (IE) is no longer supported or updated by Microsoft. As such, MEC is no longer being optimized for use with IE due to potential security concerns (since IE is no longer being supported/updated by Microsoft). While IE may work with MEC for some users, other users may experience issues. If you experience issues with MEC while using IE, please try one of the recommended browsers.

Mobile Device Users (iPhone, iPad, Android):

- MEC currently does not support any mobile web browser. While most MEC functions are accessible using mobile browsers, viewing documents in MEC on mobile browsers is not supported nor recommended.
