I write to the Court in opposition of the proposed changes of Mississippi Rules of Civil Procedure 26. Specifically, I completely join in Penny Lawson's well-reasoned objections provided to the Court in her October 23, 2023, correspondence. I concur with Ms. Lawson that the proposed change would create unneeded complications in the civil litigation process and cause insufficiencies in same. The amendment takes what is a level playing field between the litigants and tips it heavily in favor of plaintiffs, giving defendants no opportunity to address the inequities of allowing plaintiff additional chances at naming experts.

For these reasons, and the reasons set forth in Ms. Lawson's response, I respectfully object to the proposed changes.
