

Notice of Registration Requirements
Pursuant to § 45-33-39 Mississippi Code Annotated (2013)

The Defendant, _____, in _____ County Cause Number _____, having pled guilty to a sex offense or attempted sex offense; or having been found guilty of a sex offense or attempted sex offense; or having been acquitted by reason of insanity of a sex offense or attempted sex offense, is hereby notified of the duty to register and/or reregister with the Mississippi Department of Public Safety pursuant to § 45-33-25 and 45-33-31 Miss. Code Ann.

Pursuant to § 45-33-25 Miss. Code Ann., I _____, have been advised and understand that I am by law required to register with the responsible agency and I am required to provide the said registering agency the following information at the time of submission:

- (a) Name, including a former name in which has been legally changed;
- (b) Street address of all current permanent and temporary residences within state or out of state at which I reside or habitually live, including dates of temporary lodgings;
- (c) Date, place and address of employment, including as a volunteer or unpaid intern or as a transient or day laborer;
- (d) Crime for which charged, arrested or convicted;
- (e) Date and place of conviction, adjudication or acquittal by reason of insanity;
- (f) Aliases used or nicknames, ethnic or tribal names by which commonly known;
- (g) Social security number and any purported social security number or numbers;
- (h) Date and place of birth and any purported date and place of birth;
- (i) Age, race, sex, height, weight, hair and eye colors, and any other physical description or identifying factors;
- (j) A brief description of the offense or offenses for which the registration is required;
- (k) Driver's license or state or other jurisdiction identification card number, which license or card may be electronically accessed by the Department of

Public Safety;

(l) Anticipated future residence;

(m) If my residence is a motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home or manufactured home, then I shall also provide vehicle identification number, license tag number, registration number and a description, including color scheme, of the motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home or manufactured home; if my place of residence is a vessel or houseboat, then I shall also provide the hull identification number, manufacturer's serial number, name of the vessel or houseboat, registration number and a description, including color scheme, of the vessel or houseboat, including permanent or frequent locations where the motor vehicle, trailer, mobile home, manufactured home, vessel or houseboat is kept;

(n) Vehicle make, model, color and license tag number for all vehicles owned or operated by me, whether for work or personal use, and the permanent or frequent locations where the vehicle is kept;

(o) Offense history;

(p) Photograph;

(q) Fingerprints and palm prints;

(r) Documentation of any treatment received for any mental abnormality or personality disorder of the person;

(s) Biological sample;

(t) Name of any public or private educational institution, including any secondary school, trade or professional institution or institution of higher education at which I am employed, carries on a vocation (with or without compensation) or am enrolled in as a student, or will be enrolled as a student, and my status;

(u) Copy of conviction or sentencing order for the sex offense for which registration is required;

(v) My parole, probation or supervised release status and the existence of any outstanding arrest warrants;

(w) Every online identity, screen name or username used, registered or created by me;

(x) Professional licensing information which authorizes me to engage in an occupation or carry out a trade or occupation;

(y) Information from passport and immigration documents;

(z) All telephone numbers, including, but not limited to, permanent residence, temporary residence, cell phone and employment phone numbers, whether landlines or cell phones; and

(aa) Any other information deemed necessary.

I am considered to be residing in Mississippi, if I maintain a permanent or temporary residence as defined § 45-33-23.

I shall not reside within one thousand five hundred (1,500) feet of the real property comprising a public or nonpublic elementary or secondary school, a child care facility, a residential child-caring agency, a children's group care home or any playground, ballpark or other recreational facility utilized by persons under the age of eighteen (18) years; however, I am not in violation of § 45-33-25(4)(a) if one of the subsections of 45-22-25(4)(b) or (c) apply.

Pursuant to § 45-33-27 Miss. Code Ann., I am required to register with the county Sheriff within three (3) business days of the date of judgment unless I am immediately confined or committed, in which case I shall register before release in accordance with the procedures established by the department. I am also required to personally appear at the Department of Public Safety Driver's License Station within three (3) days of registration with the responsible agency and to obtain a sex offender registration card.

If I am moving to or returning to the state of Mississippi from another jurisdiction, I shall notify the Department of Public Safety ten (10) days before I first resides in or returns to Mississippi and shall present myself to the sheriff of the county of my residence within three (3) business days after first residing in or returning to a county in Mississippi to provide the required registration information. I am is also required to register by personally appearing at a Department of Public Safety Driver's License Station within three (3) days after first residing in or moving to a county in Mississippi.

Pursuant to § 45-33-29 Miss. Code Ann., upon any change of address, including temporary lodging, I am (required to register under § 45-33-29 Miss. Code Ann.), required to appear personally at a Department of Public Safety not less than ten (10) days before I intend to first reside at the new address; upon any change in the status of a my enrollment, employment or vocation at any public or private educational institution, including any secondary school, trade or professional institution or institution of higher education, I am required to personally appear at a Department of Public Safety Driver's License Station within three (3) business days of the change; and upon any change of employment or change of name, I am required to personally appear at a Department of Public Safety Driver's License Station within three (3) business days of the change; upon any change of vehicle

information, I am required to report the change on an appropriate form supplied by the department within three (3) business days of the change; upon any change of e-mail address or addresses, instant message address or addresses, or any other designation used in Internet communications, postings or telephone communications, I am required to report the change on an appropriate form supplied by the department within three (3) business days of the change; and upon any change of information deemed by the department to be necessary to the state's policy to assist local law enforcement agencies' efforts to protect their communities, I am required to report the change on an appropriate form supplied by the department within three (3) business days of the change.

Pursuant to § 45-33-31 Miss. Code Ann., I am required to personally appear at a Department of Public Safety Driver's License Station to reregister every ninety (90) days. Reregistration includes the submission of current information and photograph to the department and the verification of registration information, including my street address and telephone number; name, street address and telephone number of my employment or status at a school, along with any other registration information that may need to be verified and the payment of any required fees.

If I am in compliance with a program of electronic monitoring under § 45-33-31 Miss. Code Ann., I am required to reregister annually.

If I am not under electronic monitoring, I am required to personally appear at a Department of Public Safety Driver's License Station to reregister every ninety (90) days.

Reregistration includes the submission of current information and photograph to the department and the verification of registration information, including the street address and telephone number of the registrant; name, street address and telephone number of the registrant's employment or status at a school, along with any other registration information that may need to be verified and the payment of any required fees.

I, _____, hereby acknowledge that the Court has informed me of my duty to register. I have discussed these requirements with my attorney and understand that I am obligated to register. Failure to register could result in further criminal prosecution.
