Routine Updates

- None.

Bug Fixes

- Corrected Ad Hoc Emails from Docket Sheet to allow non-case participants to receive emails.
- Corrected Select/De-Select option that did not work on NEF screen to allow automatic selection of NEF recipients.

Enhancements

- The purpose of the enhancement in each module is designed to make the use of the selected event more user friendly to Court users of MEC.

Civil

- You will no longer be asked to attach a document when making Docket Annotations, but instead to link to the appropriate docket entry and enter the error description.

Criminal

- Docket Annotation: This menu item moved to “Other Documents under Criminal to be aligned with its Civil counterpart. You will no longer be asked to attach a document when making Docket Annotations, but instead to link to the appropriate docket entry and enter the error description.

Query/Easy Docket

- Option to include ad hoc emails from the docket sheet.
 - Select the (Yellow) Envelope from the docket report
 - Select Ad Hoc (last option)
 - **Purpose:** To allow non-case participants to receive NEF’s.
- Added Judge to Set/ Edit Time from Docket Report
 - Select the calendar with the Green arrow from the docket
 - Enter applicable information in reference to hearing being set
 - Select “Hearing” from the Type box
 - **Purpose:** To include presiding Judge on settings from docket report.

Reports

- Electronic Minute Book Reports updated to run from the Reports event.
 - Select the “Reports” tab
 - Select Electronic Minute Books
 - **Purpose:** To allow report to run from a centralized location
- Attorney-Judge Report
 - Select the “Reports” tab

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- Select the Attorney/Judge Report
- **Purpose:** To allow a Judge to receive a periodic report of new filings which includes attorney information to identify Attorney-Judge relationship for recusal purposes
