

## MEC Web Browser Compatibility:

MEC recommends the latest versions of the following web browsers for optimal performance:

- *Google Chrome*
- *Mozilla Firefox*

*Note: You can download these browsers free of charge from the respective browser websites (Google/Search "Google Chrome" or "Mozilla Firefox").*

MEC ***does not*** recommend using the following web browsers:

- *Microsoft Edge* (Windows 10 web browser) – dark blue “e” icon.
  - Edge does not currently support plugins (extensions). MEC requires Adobe PDF plugin to view documents.
- *Microsoft Internet Explorer* – light blue “e” icon.
  - Internet Explorer is no longer supported or updated by Microsoft. As such, MEC is no longer being optimized for use with IE due to potential security concerns (since IE is no longer being supported/updated by Microsoft). While IE may work with MEC for some users, other users may experience issues. If you experience issues with MEC while using IE, please try one of the recommended browsers.

**Mobile Device Users (iPhone, iPad, Android):**

- MEC currently does not support any mobile web browser. While most MEC functions are accessible using mobile browsers, viewing documents in MEC on mobile browsers is not supported nor recommended.

You must have PDF Reader software installed on your computer to view documents filed in MEC. Adobe offers free PDF Reader software on their website (<https://get.adobe.com/reader/>) or by Google/Search “Adobe PDF Reader.”
