**ORDER APPROVING CESSATION OF MANUAL  
CASE DOCKETING AND PROVIDING FOR PAPERLESS COURT  
UTILIZING THE MISSISSIPPI ELECTRONIC COURTS SYSTEM**

On the Court's own motion and pursuant to MRCP 5 and UCCR 1.13, the Court finds that the Clerk of this Court has implemented Mississippi Electronic Courts ("MEC") system in the Chancery Court of Adams County, Mississippi and further finds that all pleadings, case files, and all other Court records can be adequately maintained as part of the MEC system and hereby Orders as follows:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, as of January 1, 2020, the Clerk of Court is authorized and directed to cease manual docketing for all cases. The Clerk is further authorized and directed to begin exclusive use of the MEC system as the official system for case docketing in the Chancery Court of Adams County, Mississippi.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, as of January 1, 2020, the Clerk of this Court is authorized and directed to cease the current maintenance of paper files for all MEC cases, except as required by the Administrative Procedures for the Mississippi Electronic Courts adopted by the Court.

Pleadings previously filed in paper shall nevertheless be preserved by the Clerk in all cases, whether MEC cases or otherwise.


