**ORDER APPROVING CESSATION OF MANUAL
CASE DOCKETING AND PROVIDING FOR PAPERLESS
COURTS UTILIZING THE MISSISSIPPI ELECTRONIC COURTS**

On the Courts' own motion and pursuant to M.R.C.P. 5, UCRCCC 1.16, and MRCrP 1.7, and the Courts finding that the Clerks of these Courts have implemented the Mississippi Electronic Courts ("MEC") system in the Circuit Courts of Carroll County and further finding that all pleadings, case files, and all other Court records can be adequately maintained as part of the MEC system:


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, as of June 22, 2020, the Clerks of these Courts are authorized and directed to cease manual docketing for all cases. The Clerks are further authorized and directed to begin exclusive use of the MEC system as the official system for case docketing in the Circuit Courts of Carroll County and to maintain any and all books and dockets utilizing the MEC system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as of June 22, 2020, the Clerks of these Courts are authorized and directed to cease the current maintenance of paper files for all MEC cases, except as required by the Administrative Procedures for the Mississippi Electronic Courts adopted by these Courts.


Pleadings previously filed in paper shall nevertheless be preserved by the Clerks in all cases, whether MEC cases or otherwise.
