

**ORDER APPROVING CESSATION OF MANUAL  
CASE DOCKETING AND PROVIDING FOR PAPERLESS COURT  
UTILIZING THE MISSISSIPPI ELECTRONIC COURTS**

On the Courts' own motion and pursuant to M.R.C.P. 5 and UCRCCC 1.16, and the Courts finding that the Clerk of these Courts has implemented the Mississippi Electronic Courts ("MEC") system in the Circuit and County Courts of Pike County and further finding that all pleadings, case files, and all other Court records can be adequately maintained as part of the MEC system:


**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that, as of January 27, 2020, the Clerk of these Courts is authorized and directed to cease all other docketing for all cases. The Clerk is further authorized and directed to begin exclusive use of the MEC system as the official system for case docketing in the Circuit and County Courts of Pike County and to maintain any and all books and dockets utilizing the MEC system.


**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that, as of January 27, 2020, the Clerk of these Courts is authorized and directed to cease all other docketing for all MEC cases, except as required by the Administrative Procedures for the Mississippi Electronic Courts adopted by these Courts.

Pleadings previously filed in paper shall nevertheless be preserved by the Clerk in all cases, whether MEC cases or otherwise.
