
**IN RE: MISSISSIPPI ELECTRONIC COURTS**

**ORDER PROVIDING FOR PAPERLESS COURTS  
UTILIZING THE MISSISSIPPI ELECTRONIC COURTS**

On the Court's own motion and pursuant to M.R.C.P. 5 and UCCR 1.13, and the Court, finding that the Clerk of this Court and his staff have successfully pilot-tested and implemented the Mississippi Electronic Courts (MEC) system in the Chancery Court of DeSoto County, and further finding that all pleadings, case files, and all other Court records can be adequately maintained as part of the MEC system,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, effective as of the close of business December 31, 2012, the Clerk of this Court is authorized and directed to cease the current maintenance of paper files for all MEC cases, except as required by the Administrative Procedures for the Mississippi Electronic Courts previously adopted by this Court. Pleadings previously filed in paper form shall nevertheless be preserved by the Clerk in all cases, whether MEC cases or otherwise.
