EMERGENCY ORDER ALLOWING

In view of the Hurricane Katrina's displacement of lawyers in Louisiana, Mississippi, and Alabama, making it impossible to practice law in the affected areas, this court temporarily suspends the applicable provisions of the Supreme Court Rules Governing the Legal Profession as set forth below.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an attorney admitted to practice law in Louisiana, Mississippi or Alabama is permitted to practice law from a location in Nevada as if the attorney were located in the state in which the attorney is licensed, provided that the attorney is in good standing with the attorney's respective state bar and is displaced from the attorney's home jurisdiction due to Hurricane Katrina. This special authority to practice law from Nevada is valid until March 15, 2006, and is limited to representing existing or new clients who have been displaced from the attorney's state of licensure by Hurricane Katrina and any other clients with whom the attorney has an ongoing attorney-client relationship.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that an attorney practicing pursuant to this order shall be subject to the Nevada Rules of Professional Conduct and other Rules of the Nevada Supreme Court. Within 5 days of

engaging in the practice of law in Nevada pursuant to this order, the attorney must provide to the State Bar of Nevada his or her name, Nevada address or contact information, and license number issued by the attorney's home state. No application or licensure fees shall be required of the lawyers subject to this order.
