ORDER APPROVING CESSATION OF MANUAL CASE DOCKETING AND PROVIDING FOR PAPERLESS COURT UTILIZING THE MISSISSIPPI ELECTRONIC COURTS

On the Courts' own motions and pursuant to M.R.C.P. 5 and UCCR 1.13, and the Courts finding that the Clerk of these Courts has implemented the Mississippi Electronic Courts ("MEC") system in the Chancery Courts of Chickasaw County and further finding that all pleadings, case files, and all other Court records can be adequately maintained as part of the MEC system:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, as of July 1, 2022, the Clerk of these Courts is authorized and directed to cease manual docketing for all cases. The Clerk is further authorized and directed to begin exclusive use of the MEC system as the official system for case docketing in the Chancery Courts of Chickasaw County and to maintain any and all books and dockets utilizing the MEC system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as of July 1, 2022, the Clerk of these Courts is authorized and directed to cease the current maintenance of paper files for all MEC cases, except as required by the Administrative Procedures for the Mississippi Electronic Courts adopted by these Courts.
