case docketing in the Circuit Courts of Choctaw County and to maintain any and all civil books

and civil dockets utilizing the MEC system.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as of April 15, 2022, the Clerk of this Court is

authorized and directed to cease the current maintenance of paper files for all MEC civil cases,

except as required by the Administrative Procedures for the Mississippi Electronic Courts adopted

by this Court.
