

Additional XML information that is not included in the schema:

1) **XML FILE NAMING CONVENTION**

{ SENDERID } + _ + { CaseType } + _ + { TRANSACTIONNUMBER } + .xml

Example: 0322105_C_250.xml **CIVIL XML FILE NAME EXAMPLE**

Example: 0322105_R_250.xml **CRIMINAL XML FILE NAME EXAMPLE**

2) **ZIP FILE NAMING CONVENTION**

{ SENDERID } + _ + { CaseType } + _ + { TRANSACTIONNUMBER } + .zip

Example: 0322105_C_250.zip **CIVIL ZIP FILE NAME EXAMPLE**

Example: 0322105_R_250.zip **CRIMINAL ZIP FILE NAME EXAMPLE**

(Note: Multiple XML files can be contained within one ZIP file. The ZIP file name used is the name of the last XML file added to the ZIP file in the ZIP File Naming Convention above.)

MULTIPLE XML FILES IN ONE ZIP FILE NAMING EXAMPLE

0322105_C_251.xml – 0322105_C_300.xml are 50 xml files that can be added to the ZIP file named 0322105_C_300.zip.

3) **REFERENCE TABLES**

4) **SENDERID**

Create the SENDERID by concatenating the following four (4) fields:

1) COURTID “mask 00”

2) COUNTYID “mask 00”

3) JUDICIALDISTRICT “mask 0”

4) DISTRICT “mask 00”

Example: COURTID = 3 (pad 03), COUNTYID = 22,

JUDICIALDISTRICT = 1, DISTRICT = 5 (pad 05),

Resulting concatenation equals 0322105.

5) **XML SCHEMA VALIDATION**

Civil and Criminal XML data must be validated before it can be imported. The AltovaXML validating parser is a free tool that will validate xml data against a schema.
