Section 25-3-41 of the Mississippi Code of 1972 and as later ordered by the Court. The
temporary additional court reporter shall take her oath and be bonded as required by law.

Administrative Office of Courts, Post Office Box 117, Jackson, Mississippi 39201 and deliver a
copy of the Order to the court reporter, [Name and Address of Court Reporter].
